

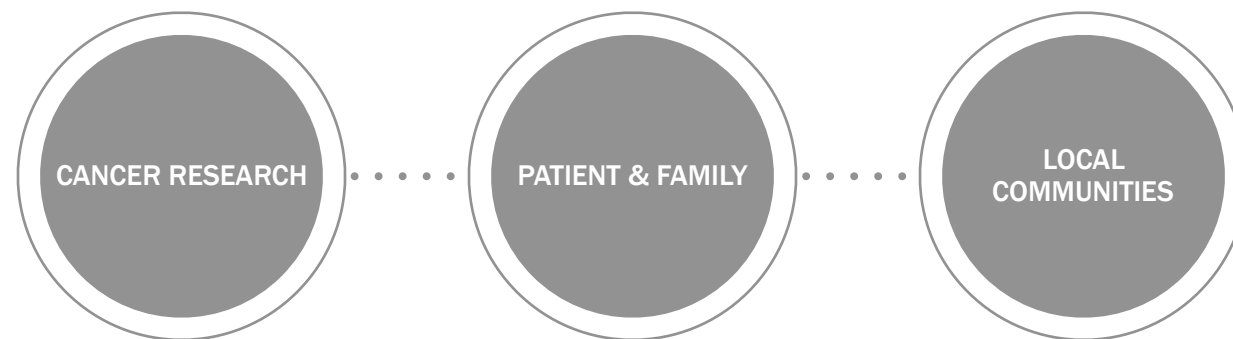

## Summary of events

### Bandana Bash

Bandana Bash was Leukemia 24-7's annual benefit event from 2010-2014.

Each year, hundreds of supporters would attend this outdoor event, which featured live music, local artisans and most importantly, a bone marrow registry drive. From 2010-2014, this event raised \$95,508 in net contributions.

### Todd Zick Golf Classic

Our annual golf tournament, the first of which was held 2015, has continued to grow year over year.

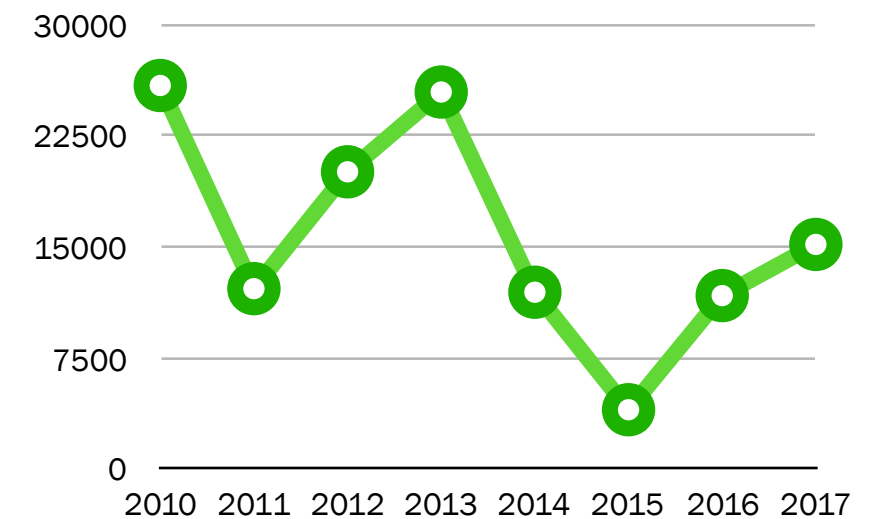
The event most recently drew 19 sponsors and 140 golfers. Each year, approximately 200 people attend this event and over the last three years, it has raised \$30,867 in net contributions.
